Why myshare?

myshare is:

- › A storage appliance that plugs into the network through a gigabit interface with up to 2 TBs of storage capacity.

myshare can:

- › Backup photos, movies, music and other files.
- › Share content with all computers on the network.
- › Remote access from across the internet.
- › Consolidate storage capacity to be shared with all members of a home or small office.
- › Operate as a storage appliance for USB drives and printers.
- › Create a common ground to edit and play movies from PCs and Macs.
- › Archive files for long term storage.
- › Stream digital content.

myshare replaces:

- › Externally attached storage
- › Add-on Internal disk drives
- › Removable Media
- › Print Servers
- › Remote Storage

myshare will go:

- › Anywhere on the network; myshare will sit conveniently under any home router or switch.

Save with myshare:

- › Consolidate storage capacity among all members of a network.
- › Centralize printing with one printer for all networked computers.
- › Plug in current USB drives and turn them instantly into shared storage.

Make myshare wireless:

- › By plugging the myshare into a wireless router, enjoy all features from the backyard, the neighbor's house, the conference room or from any room in the house.
- › Configure myshare to be accessible from the Internet to share photos and movies with friends and family or access business documents from a hotel room.
- › With a wireless media receiver, stream music, photos, or videos to TVs or stereo systems.

Centralize your Digital Home

- Share a printer with all members of the household.

- Use the USB upload button to copy digital pictures to the myshare.

Consolidate your Digital Household

- Add on USB drives for additional capacity and share them with all users on the network.
- Share up to 2.0 TBs of capacity between the members of your household.
- Organize movies, photos and pictures in a single location.
- Create private folders and access for each member of the household.
- Use the public folder to share

- Plug the myshare into a wireless router and share without wires.
- Print from any room in the house.

Increased Data Protection
